- ✓ Overseeing and support the various student activities,
- ✓ guiding the character of the student by development and care taking through extracurricular and creative activities especially for talented students,

- ✓ guiding the students in psychological, educational and academic matters,
- ✓ arranging the annual graduation ceremony of students,
- ✓ familiarizing new students with the university facilities and services,
- ✓ follow-up of student financial issues jointly with the Students’ Unity and the Financial Department,
- ✓ Considering complaints and irregularities by some students and adjust their behavior.
